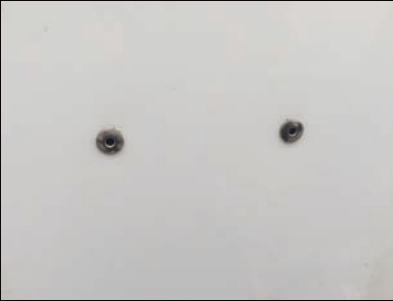

The photos are not retouched. The difference is obvious. TrailerBlade panel is a steel composite panel, a close cousin to what's on the trailer. It has a plastic core (we said we liked plastic) that helps give it its legendary flexibility but that plastic core is sandwiched between two galvanized steel panels and then covered with a polyester coating that is identical to what's on the trailer panels, to protect it from the cracking, checking, graying, UV damage and breakdown that you see in the brands above. You would not let the rest of your trailer age this way. So why are you allowing it on your side skirts?
